By receiving this packet, you have taken the first of several official steps toward becoming an academy graduate and helping lead the future of our great nation. Please carefully follow the instructions provided. Be as thorough and timely in all of your submittals as possible.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. You **MUST**:

- Be of good moral character.
- Be at least 17 years old but not have passed your 23rd birthday.
NOTE: For Merchant Marine- you must not have passed your 25th birthday before July 1 in the year of entrance.
- Be a United States citizen at the time of entrance to the academy.
- Be unmarried, not pregnant, and without legal obligation to support children or other dependents.
- Be a resident within the boundaries of the 11th Congressional District of Florida.
- Meet the medical, physical, and academic requirements and high standards of each academy.
- Never been convicted of violating a state or federal statute.

2. You **MUST contact the academy of your choice to request a pre-candidate application**. In order for our review board to consider your application for your nomination, you need to have an open application file with that specific academy.

NOTE: As you know, the honor of attending a Service Academy comes with an obligation and commitment to serve in the military for a minimum of five years upon graduation.

3. You are encouraged to apply to every nominating authority available to you. Please note that each office has different procedures and deadlines, therefore read all instructions carefully.

APPLICATION INFORMATION

Please note that my office will **not accept a partial application**. Your application must be submitted in its entirety no later than October 4th, 2024. If you submit a partial application, it will be discarded, and you will be asked to submit a complete application. If you fail to submit a completed application, you will be ineligible for a congressional nomination interview.

1. Form:

- The completed application form needs to be sent to the Clermont district office as soon as possible.
- Be sure to include a current wallet-sized photo (2 ½" by 3 ½").

2. Transcripts:

- An official high school transcript which includes your course listing, current GPA, grades, and class rank, needs to be mailed to the Clermont district office by your guidance counselor.
- If you are enrolled in a college, university, or academy prep school, please ask them to mail a current official transcript as well.

3. Entrance Examinations

- You are **required** by the service academies and your committee to participate in either the SAT or the ACT. Arrangements to take these tests may be made through your high school guidance office or by writing directly to the following addresses:

- Request that the official SAT or ACT examination results be mailed to Congressman Daniel Webster's Clermont district office.
 - SAT code: 5469
 - ACT code: 7331

- Our office **MUST** receive **official** test scores. Scores on transcripts do not meet this requirement. **Please be advised that it takes several weeks for our office to receive your test scores so please plan accordingly.** NOTE: Test scores must be received in the Clermont district office by close of business on **October 4, 2024**.
- It is highly advisable to take the college entrance exams as often as possible.

4. Academic Recommendation:

- The Academic Recommendation Form must be completed and included in your completed application packet.

5. Recommendation Forms:

- **Three** recommendation forms must be completed by people that know you well (minister, coach, scoutmaster, teacher, or employer) and are not members of your family. Be very selective in who you ask to complete your recommendation forms. Recommendation forms must be accompanied by a letter from each recommender. Recommendation forms and letters must include in your completed application packet.

6. Essays:

- **Two** 500–800-word essays, typed and double-spaced, must be submitted.
- The essays should answer the following questions:
 - Why do you want to attend a military academy and serve as an officer in the United States Armed Forces?
 - What do you see yourself doing in ten years regarding personal, professional, and family goals?

7. Deadline:

- The completed application packet must be received in the Clermont district office by close of business on **October 4, 2024 (postmarked by October 4, will not be accepted, packets must be in the office)**. It must be mailed or delivered to the following address:

8. Interview:

- **IF** you meet at least the minimum requirements, you may be scheduled for an interview with Congressman Webster's Service Academy Nomination Selection Board at the end of October/beginning of November.

9. Verification:

- Please contact our office at 352-241-9220 to verify that we have received each portion of the application packet.

***Students need to be the ones keeping in contact with the Service Academy Coordinator. We encourage parental involvement, but request that the student show the initiative in pursuing the nomination.**

HELPFUL HINTS:

- Register with each military academy in which you have an interest; applying to one academy does not mean that you have applied to all four.
- Obtain the appropriate paperwork from the academy for your DODMERB medical exam. Once this is completed by your medical physician, return it promptly to the academy.
- Confirm that each portion of the application packet has been received and that your file is complete.
- Please note that a completed application packet does NOT guarantee an interview.
- Once your interview date has been offered, it cannot be rescheduled. Therefore, keep the date open on your calendar.
- Update Congressman Webster's office with SAT/ACT scores, senior year leadership positions, or important correspondence from the academy via fax (352-241-9220) or mail.
