Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for Hooks Street Extension in t Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Lake County, Florida, located at 315 W Main Street, Tavares, FL 32778. The funding would be used to construct roadway, roundabouts, trails, sidewalks signing & markings, drainage, lighting, signalization, and more on Hooks Street between Hancock Road and Country Road 455 in the City of Clermont.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because extending Hooks Street between Hancock Road and County Road 455 in Clermont would create an important east-west reliever route for State Road 50, one of the region's most heavily traveled corridor. The connection would enhance mobility for residents, businesses, and emergency services while improving access to nearby neighborhoods, schools, and commercial areas.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 23 USC 133.
